THIS INDENTURE made this Thirtieth day of November One thousand nine hundred and Twenty-one BETWEEN ANUNDRAM SHROFF son of Hiranund Shroff deceased of No. P77 Surtibagan Street in the town of Calcutta by caste Agarwallah by profession merchant of the one part and SEWARAM SHROFF son of the said Hiranund Shroff deceased of No. 184, Cross Street in Calcutta aforesaid of the same ~~same~~ caste and occupation of the other part WHEREAS the said Anundram Shroff and Sewaram Shroff have been carrying on business in co-partnership as cloth merchants Shroffs and commission agents at Calcutta and other places under the name and style of Hiranund Anundram each of the parties being entitled to one equal half share thereof AND WHEREAS out of the profits of the said business the said parties purchased amongst other properties the premises No. 184, Cross Street formerly No. 69/4, (and which comprises a portion formerly part of No. 37, Armenian Street) No. 8, formerly No. 10, Nilmadhub Sen Lane, 8 and 12 (formerly No. 39) Bhawani Churn Dutt Lane one one third share of the premises No. 203, Harrison Road and one half share in the joint household premises Nos. 3 and 4 Jogemohun Mullick's Lane AND WHEREAS for the sake of convenience the said parties hereto agreed to effect an amicable partition of the said properties and appointed Debi Bux Shroff and Luchminarayan Shroff as the Arbitrators to make a division AND WHEREAS the said Debi Bux Shroff and Luchminarayan Shroff made a partition of the division thereof and allotted the premises No. 184, Cross Street valued at Rupees One Lac seventy-five thousand and the divided Southern portion of premises No. 8, formerly No. 10, Nilmadhub Sen Lane delineated in the plan hereto annexed marked B and coloured chocolate thereon valued at Rupees Twenty-five thousand to the said Sewaram Shroff and allotted the premises No. 8 and 12, formerly No. 39, Bhawani Churn Dutt Lane valued at Rupees One lac and the divided Northern portion of the said premises No. 8, formerly No. 10, Nilmadhub Sen Lane delineated in the plan and marked "A" and coloured yellow thereon valued at Rupees Twenty-five thousand to the said Anundram Shroff and directed the said premises No. 203, Harrison Road and No. 3 and 4, Jogemohun Mullick's Lane to remain joint AND WHEREAS the total valuation of the properties so partitioned & allotted is Rs 3,25000/- AND WHEREAS the difference in value of the said allotments has been debited against the name and share of the said Sewaram Shroff in the said business and WHEREAS the said Sewaram Shroff hath asked the said Anundram Shroff to execute in his favour the necessary mutual Conveyance in respect of the portion so allotted to him as aforesaid which the said Anundram Shroff hath agreed to do NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that in pursuance of the said Agreement and in consideration of the premises he the said Anundram Shroff doth by these presents irrevocably grant convey transfer and release unto the said Sewaram Shroff his heirs executors administrators representatives and assigns all those messuages lands -----
